Q and A on Social Security

Each month, the Social Security Administration provides some common questions and answers that may apply to you or your family. If you have any questions you would like to be answered, call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213.

Q I am 50 years old and I have lost my Social Security card. Since I know my number, should I replace my Social Security card?

A Since your Social Security card is the only official proof of your Social Security number, we suggest that you apply for a replacement card. For information about what you need to do to get a replacement card, see "Documents You Need for a Social Security Card" on the Social Security website at www.socialsecurity.gov. Or you can call Social Security's toll-free number at 1-800-772-1213 (TTY 1-800-325-0778) and ask for the publication *Your Social Security Number and Card*.
