**Does my baby really need a Social Security number?**

# A

*In most cases, yes, as you will need the child's number in order to claim your child as a dependent on your federal tax return. We encourage all parents to apply for a Social Security card for their children. In fact, nine out of 10 parents apply for a Social Security card while still in the hospital. In addition to needing your child's number for a federal tax deduction, the number is also needed when filing for certain government benefits. 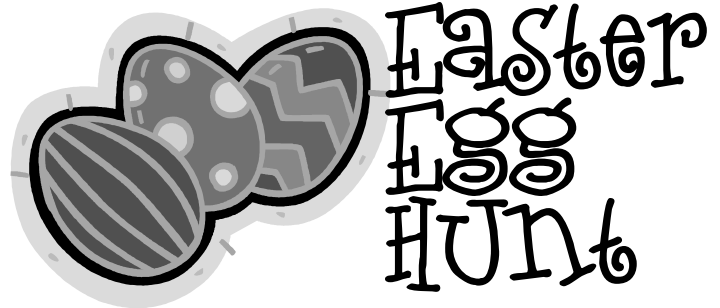
