## Q and A on Social Security

Each month, the Social Security Administration provides some common questions and answers that may apply to you or your family. If you have any questions you would like to be answered, call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213.

**Q** I have developed some physical ailments as I have aged, and now think that I may need to hire someone to help me out with household chores. What are my responsibilities for paying Social Security taxes if someone works at my house just a day or two a week?



If you pay your worker \$1,400 or more in cash wages during 2005, increasing to \$1,500 in 2006, you must deduct Social Security and Medicare taxes and report the wages once a year.
