Q and A on Social Security

Each month, the Social Security Administration provides some common questions and answers that may apply to you or your family. If you have any questions you would like to be answered, call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213.

Q I was married to my ex-husband for 14 years and I have been told that he now has serious health problems from which he is not expected to recover. What Social Security benefits would our two children, now ages 11 and 8, be eligible for if he dies?

A Assuming that your ex-husband worked and paid Social Security taxes, survivors benefits would be paid to his unmarried children who are younger than 18—or up to age 19 if they are attending elementary or secondary school full-time.
