Q and A on Social Security

Each month, the Social Security Administration provides some common questions and answers that may apply to you or your family. If you have any questions you would like to be answered, call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213.

Q Is a statement from your doctor saying you are disabled enough to qualify you for Social Security disability benefits?

A No. The Disability Determination Services Office in your state gathers your medical records, asks your doctor for specific medical information and may schedule a special examination for you. Then a team consisting of a physician (or psychologist) and a disability evaluation specialist will consider all the facts in your case and decide if you are disabled according to Social Security's rules.
