Q and A on Social Security

Each month, the Social Security Administration provides some common questions and answers that may apply to you or your family. If you have any questions you would like to be answered, call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213.

Q My oldest aunt has told me that I have been named executor of her estate. Among the questions I have is this: when a Social Security beneficiary dies, does the funeral home notify Social Security or is notification up to the family?

A Many funeral directors voluntarily provide death information directly to Social Security. But family members of a deceased individual still have the legal responsibility to notify Social Security.
