Q and A on Social Security

Each month, the Social Security Administration provides some common questions and answers that may apply to you or your family. If you have any questions you would like to be answered, call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213.

Q I am almost 50 years old, and did not work for more than 20 years while taking care of my children, and then going back to school to earn a degree. I was wondering if I can get more Social Security credits by working more than one job?

A The maximum number of Social Security credits that a person can get in a year is four. In 2005, you receive one credit for every \$920 of covered earnings, up to the four-credit maximum. An additional job would probably not increase your credits, but may give you a higher benefit amount when you retire.
