Wednesday, May 10, 6 p.m., Skateland. Lincoln Family Night! Roller skating! Grab on and bring the whole family for a fun night!!!



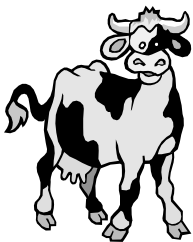
LINCOLN PTO BASH!

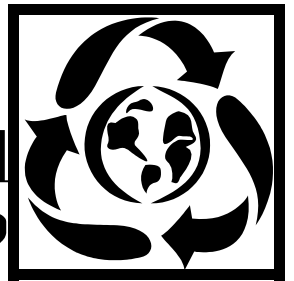
