Q and A on Social Security

Each month, the Social Security Administration provides some common questions and answers that may apply to you or your family. If you have any questions you would like to be answered, call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213.

Q My sister has become very ill and I am helping her get together the information and documents needed to apply for Social Security disability benefits. Will Social Security accept photocopies instead of original documents as evidence when she applies for benefits?

 Social Security will accept photocopies of W-2 forms, self-employment tax returns or medical documents, but must see the originals of almost all other documents. If all needed documents are not available, do not delay filing for benefits. Social Security will work with your sister to help get them.
