Q and A on Social Security

Each month, the Social Security Administration provides some common questions and answers that may apply to you or your family. If you have any questions you would like to be answered, call the Social Security Office at 1-800-772-1213.

Q My granddaughter is 18 years old. In her junior year of high school, she had an accident that paralyzed her right side. It doesn't look like she'll be able to work in the near future.

Because she did not work long enough under Social Security to qualify for benefits, is there any other program that could help her?



Supplemental Security Income (SSI) is a needs-based program paid for by general tax revenue and run by the Social Security Administration. It can help people like your granddaughter who are disabled and who have not paid enough in Social Security taxes to qualify for regular Social Security disability benefits. To qualify for SSI, a person must be disabled, and have limited resources and income. You should know also that if the child's parents are receiving Social Security benefits or they are deceased, she may be eligible for Disabled Adult Child (DAC) under Social Security.
